

For a safer PASSWORD

Things to avoid-Common Compromises

- X Avoid using your name, spouse name, children name, Organisation name, City/village/state names etc. Also avoid using ABC, XYZ or three consecutive letters like aaa, bbb, nnn, mmm etc.
- X Avoid using numbers like your year of birth, Spouse/children year of birth, your bike, your car's Registration number etc.
- X Avoid using numbers 123, 456, 789 etc.
- X Avoid using special character @.
- X Password may not start with Capital letter.
- X Do not limit your password to eight character length.

Things to Do

- Instead of using English, use your local Language in Roman script – like dilli instead of Delhi
- Instead of using first letter capital use 3rd or 4th letter as capital
- Use numbers which are not easily guessable like part of your pin-code of your native place or some digits from your previous phone number, or any other number; again all jumbled.
- Use any special character other than @.
- Instead of using single word use multiple words, preferably jumbled.

And how not to forget a password

- Instead of a word Use a sentence like 1_2_love_Sahajdigital
- better use more than 14 characters for a password
